Remembrance Day is a federal statutory holiday in Canada. Some of the 54 Commonwealth member states observe this tradition on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month, the day WWI ended, to remember those who died in military service, and to honour those who served in wartime.

The **Poppies** that flourished in the soil churned up by the fighting and shelling inspired Canadian doctor John McCrae to write 'In Flanders Fields' whilst serving in Ypres in 1915. In 1918, responding to McCrae's poem, American humanitarian Moina Michael wrote 'And now the Torch and Poppy Red, we wear in honor of our dead...'. She campaigned to make the poppy the symbol we know today. Artificial poppies were first sold in Britain in 1921 to raise money in support of ex-servicemen and the families of those who had died in the war.
